- Seeing an increase in violence related calls. Assaults and Assaults with Weapons.

4.4 Strategic Plan- targets and highlights

Target 1:

 Safe Neighborhood Camera Registry is live and available for residents and businesses of Altona and Plum Coulee to register their security camera's.

- Cpl Legal to attend training in Ottawa for Incident Command 300.
- Cst Funk to attend training for child sex abuse interview.
- Digital Evidence Management training is ongoing. The Province of Manitoba Justice is hoping to launch this program in mid-November
- Chief Defer attended meeting held by Canadian Association Chiefs of Police
